





Alpine Level 1 Exam Schedule

Course Schedules are subject to change due to terrain, weather, crowds, group size, snow conditions, etc. Please use this information as a rough guideline.

Day 1:	
8:30-9:00	Meet your clinician leader at the designated meeting location (a confirmation email noting the location will be emailed to you the day prior). Introduce yourself to the group.
9:00-10:00	1st group activity which will clarify and explain Level 1 understanding of Skill Concept
10:15-12:00	Group activity to move from skills concept to MA. (National Standard expects description of skill use only)
12:30-2:15 (including 30 min lunch)	Ski/Ride
2:30-3:3:30	Each candidate gives a 5 min teach presentation (10 min total with follow up). Focused on the 1st 3 steps of teaching cycle.
3:30-4:00	Wrap up for the day: Clarify any feedback given throughout the day. Handout teaching scenarios for the next day. Outline day 2 schedule.
Day 2:	
8:30-9:00	Answer candidate questions and get ready for the day.
9:00-10:00	Review any areas in Ski/Ride that need more time.
10:15-1:45 (including 30 min lunch)	20-min teaching presentation from day 1 assignment (30 min with follow up)
2:00-3:00	Follow up with candidates as needed
3:00-4:30	Distribution of score cards and exit interviews
